Trained dogs are used to find the naturally grown Italian black summer truffles that give this

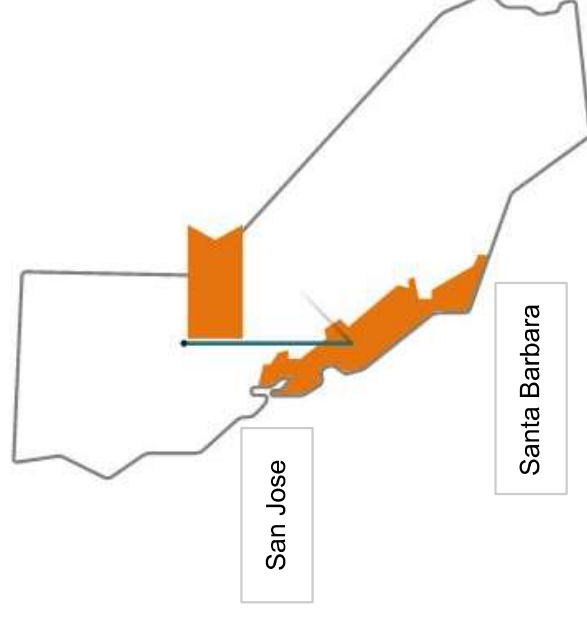

LIEU DIT CHENIN

As we head into crisper nights around the firepit, Chenin blanc is a great choice for those of you who are looking for a white that will transition you straight into Fall. It's a great tailgate wine, and pairs incredibly well with chicken wings! Chenin blanc is primarily grown in the Loire region of France. It has a bit more body and viscosity than say a sauvignon blanc. Lieu Dit Chenin is full of floral and honeyed aromas and quince and apple-like flavors (cue the leaves falling!). Lieu Dit winery was founded in 2011 and focuses on Loire varietals, which winemaker Justin Willett says grows beautifully here. **Retail \$29.99**

CHERRY HOUSE by VILLA CREEK

Paso Robles is on the rise, and perhaps no winery more so than Villa Creek. With a bevy of 94-97 pt reviews from Jeb Dunnuck, Wine Advocate and Vinous, the wines are becoming increasingly hard to find

The wine explodes from the glass with aromas of red cherries, raspberries and cranberries, leading into flavors of the same, along with hints of anise and subtle floral notes. **Retail \$29.99**

GLUNZ ZINFANDEL

Aromatics of red cherry and vanilla. On the palate loads of dark fruit, raspberry and toast. The Glunz family story started in 1871 when Louis Glunz, age 17, left his country of Germany in pursuit of the American dream. Louis arrived in Ellis Island that year with friends Oscar Meyer and Theo Koshwermill. The three moved from city to city in search of work until they arrived in the boomtown of Chicago in 1872. Louis Glunz was able to set up a shop as a wine, beer and spirit merchant on Wells Street and Division Street.

TIMBRE THE CLASSICS

Bordeaux is known for blends from 5 main varieties and this wine has all of them. 43% Merlot, 21% Cab Franc, 14% Malbec, 11% Cab Sauv, and 11% Petit Verdot is the breakdown. Dark red this wine is silky smooth, like a velour tracksuit. Smells like red Kool-Aid, sweet cherries, red licorice, plum, and blackberry. Fruity on the palate, but also earthy with black coffee, black pepper, cedar, and graphite

ADELAIDA PINOT NOIR

Adelaida has six organically-farmed vineyards in the coastal influenced Santa Lucia Mountain Range on the west side of the Paso Robles AVA. This Pinot has true-to-type aromas of drying cherries, mountainous forest glades, and wild shrub roses that invite tasting and exploration. In the mouth, the purity of fruit captivates with essences of cherry followed by a wild wave of savory flavors that draws the fruit notes to an elongated finish.
